

## Threats to Early Childhood Development


Maternal mortality	389/100 000	Young mothers (births by 18y)	17%
Low birthweight	9%	Preterm births	14%
Child poverty	49%	Under 5 stunting	25%
Harsh punishment	88%	Inadequate supervision	39%

## Lifetime cost of growth deficit in early childhood







Estimate in terms of % loss of annual adult wage
