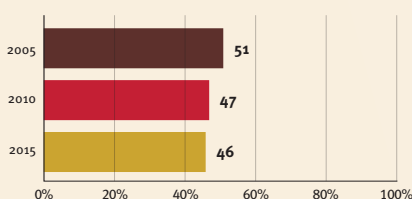

Threats to Early Childhood Development

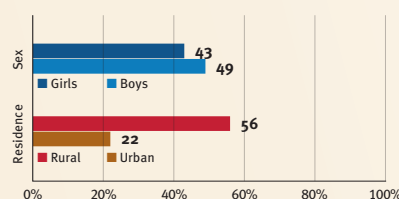
Maternal mortality	458/100 000	Young mothers (births by 18y)	22%
Low birthweight	13%	Preterm births	17%
Child poverty	23%	Under-five stunting	27%
Violent discipline	63%	Inadequate supervision	19%

Young children at risk of poor development

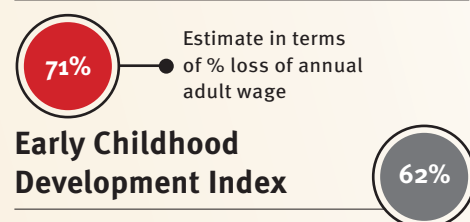


At risk in 2005, 2010 and 2015, using a composite indicator of under-five stunting or poverty

Risk by sex and residence

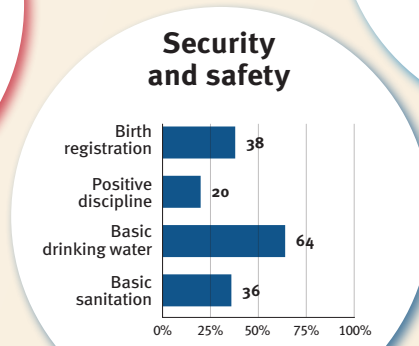
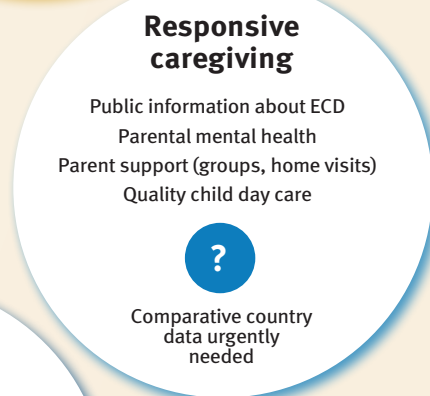
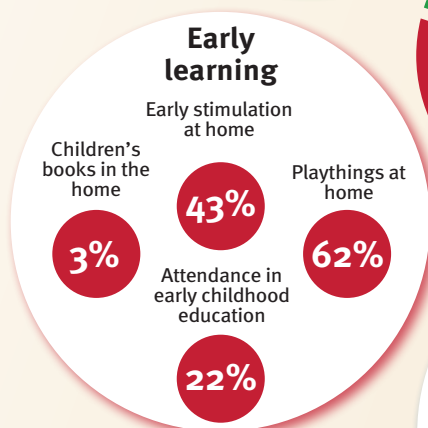
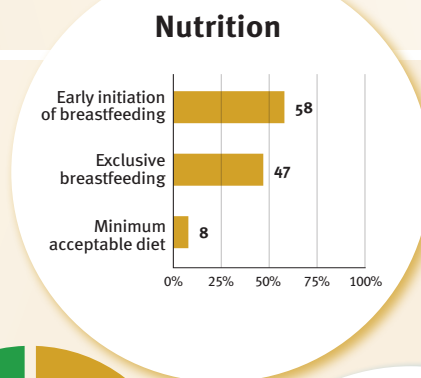
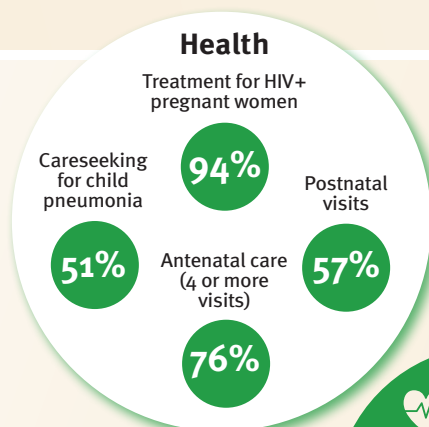


Lifetime cost of growth deficit in early childhood
