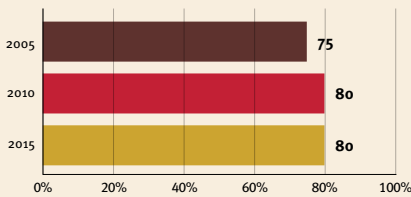

Threats to Early Childhood Development

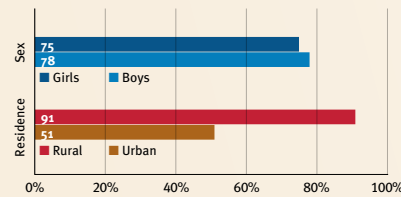
Maternal mortality	829/100,000	Young mothers (births by 18y)	45%
Low birthweight	15%	Preterm births	13%
Child poverty	64%	Under-five stunting	41%
Violent discipline	90%	Inadequate supervision	61%

Young children at risk of poor development

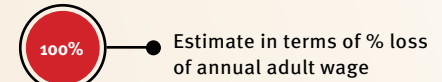


At risk in 2005, 2010 and 2015, using a composite indicator of under-five stunting or poverty
