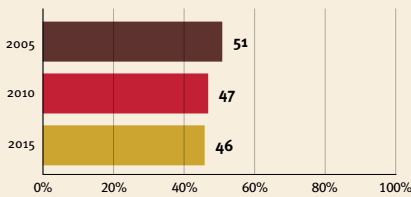

Threats to Early Childhood Development

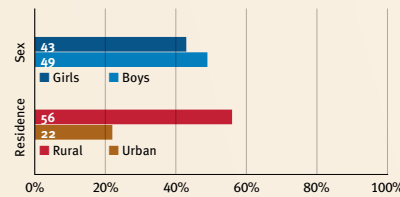
Maternal mortality	458/100,000	Young mothers (births by 18y)	24%

Young children at risk of poor development

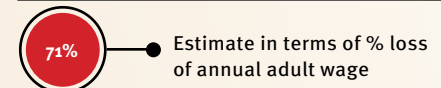


At risk in 2005, 2010 and 2015, using a composite indicator of under-five stunting or poverty

Children with functional difficulty



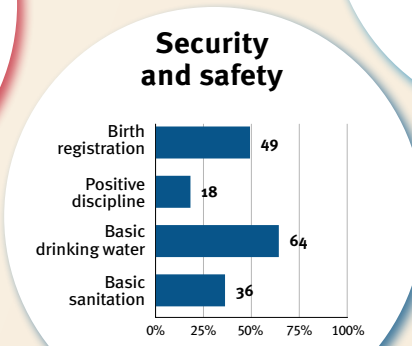
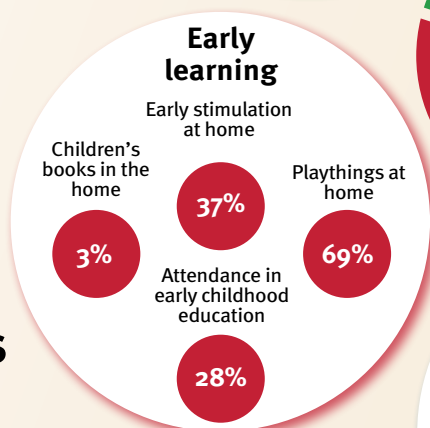
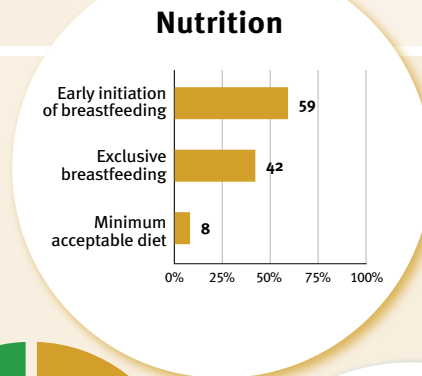
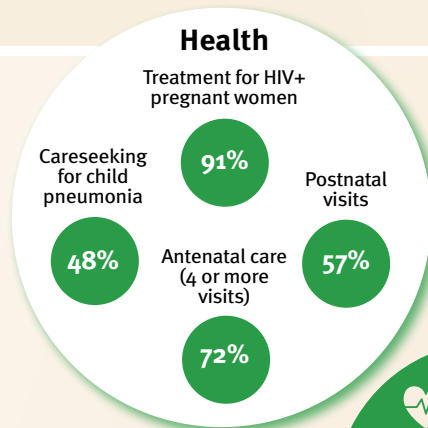
